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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED ORDINANCE PROHIBITING USE OF STREETS AND SIDEWALKS FOR STATIONARY VENDING AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 21-2009

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Juan County Council will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of receiving testimony on a proposed ordinance: An Ordinance Prohibiting Use of Streets and Sidewalks for Stationary Vending and Repealing Ordinance 21-2009. The public hearing will be held in the Council Hearing Room at 55 Second Street, Friday Harbor, Washington on Tuesday, March 30, 2010 beginning at 10:45 AM. The hearing may be continued from time to time and place to place as may be desired by the Council without additional written notice.

At the hearing, members of the public will be invited to speak and/or provide written statements regarding the proposed ordinance. After the public testimony portion of the hearing has ended, the commissioners will deliberate and consider modifications to the ordinance that are proposed by members of the public, the county employees or the Council. The proposed ordinance may then be adopted with or without modifications.

The proposed ordinance prohibits vendors from selling products on county road right-of-ways within the boundaries of Eastsound, Lopez Village, Olga, Deer Harbor and Orcas Village. Ordinance 21-2009 which required a use permit for vendors is repealed.

All persons wishing to be heard on this matter are encouraged to attend. Written comments may be submitted in advance of the hearing by mail or at the hearing by delivery in person. The ordinance(s) are filed at the office of the County Council, 55 Second Street, Friday Harbor, WA.
