


**Official Map for  
Orcas Bay Marine Protected Area Shoreline Overlay Environment**

Apply the Marine Protected Area (MPA) shoreline overlay environment designation to the tidelands of parcels 262222032000, 262222027000, 262221003000, and 262221004000. For these parcels the landward boundary shall be the line of Ordinary High Water (OHW), the seaward boundary shall be the line of Extreme Low Water (ELW), and the western boundary shall be at the western line of ownership of parcel number 262222032000 and shall extend from the line of OHW seaward to the line of ELW. The MPA designation shall also apply to a portion of the shoreline along the outer face of the breakwater for the Bay Head Marina, parcel number 262250019000. The land ward boundary on that parcel shall be a line along the longitudinal axis of the breakwater for the Bay Head Marina: This line shall proceed from the northwest boundary of parcel number 262250019000, from where it intersects the OHW line of parcel 262221004000, then shall proceed along the axis of the breakwater to the midpoint (approximately 260 feet from the northwest boundary of parcel number 262250019000). The eastern boundary shall be a line transverse to the axis at the midpoint, and shall extend seaward to the line of ELW as established by the fill of the breakwater. The seaward boundary shall proceed along this established line of ELW until it intersects the ELW line of parcel 262221004000. Boundaries of the MPA as shown on the map are approximate.
