

RESOLUTION NO. 25 - 2010

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF
NORTH BEACH ROAD AND PRUNE ALLEY ON ORCAS ISLAND
AND
BAYSHORE ROAD ON LOPEZ ISLAND
FOR VARIOUS CIVIC EVENTS

BACKGROUND:

- A. Various civic organizations have requested the closure of portions of County Roads for various community events as shown on Attachment "A".
- B. Chapter 10.04 of San Juan County Code adopts by reference the Washington Model Traffic Ordinance (WAC 308-330).
- C. WAC 308-330-270(7) gives the County Council the authority to temporarily close any highway (County Road) after an investigation by the traffic engineer.
 - a. San Juan County Ordinance 46-2009 requires a \$100.00 nonrefundable fee for a Temporary Road Closure Permit.
 - b. The various organizations have submitted the \$100.00 fee.
- D. The San Juan County Engineer reviewed and recommended temporary closure of County roads shown on Attachment "A".
- E. It will be in the best interest of the citizens of San Juan County to temporarily close portions of County roads for various community events as shown on Attachment "A".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Council approve the temporary closure of County Roads under the following conditions:

1. All property owners within the closure area are notified of the proposed closure.
2. Barricades are installed at both ends of the closure.
3. Barricades are staffed to give directions and information.
4. Provisions are made for emergency response through the closed area.
5. Easel boards be placed one week prior to the closure informing the public of the time and date of the proposed closure.
6. The closure is granted as shown on Attachment "A".
7. The County Sheriff be notified three days prior to the event.


The conditions are to be met by the organizations.
