

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

SAN JUAN COUNTY POINT LAWRENCE ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT ORCAS ISLAND, WASHINGTON

BID DATE: March 22, 2011

Sealed bids will be received at the San Juan County Council office for the San Juan County ***POINT LAWRENCE ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT*** project until **1:00 p.m. on March 22, 2011**. The physical address for the Council Office is 55 Second Street, Friday Harbor, Washington, 98250 and the mailing address is 350 Court Street, #1, Friday Harbor, Washington, 98250. A public bid opening will take place at **1:00 p.m. on March 22, 2011**, at the San Juan County Legislative Building Hearing Room, 55 Second Street, Friday Harbor, Washington.

SCOPE OF WORK

Replace one (1) 30 inch culvert with a 43 foot span by 28 foot wide precast concrete piling supported bridge. Excavate 19 foot wide bridge channel and install rock wall erosion control. Install utilities and their supports under new bridge channel sections. Pour 6 inch thick reinforced concrete bridge deck and 13-inch thick reinforced concrete bridge approach slabs in accordance with the Contract Plans, the Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications. Install Temporary Detour Road, restoration plantings, and guardrails. Installation of the Detour road fill below +8.0 tidal elevation and within the wetted perimeter of Cascade Creek cannot begin until **June 15, 2011**. Detour road must be removed by **September 30, 2011**.

PROJECT LOCATION

The project location is on Point Lawrence Road, Mile Post 0.2, east of Olga Hamlet, on Orcas Island, San Juan County, Washington.

MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT STORAGE AREA

A 138 foot by 50 foot area is available for contractor use immediately north east of the project site on the Taylor property. Contractor must find additional area as needed.

PROJECT COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The project shall be Substantially Completed within 90 working days FROM "Notice to Proceed", including sub-contracted items.

FUNDS

The project is financed with a combination of local and State Salmon Recovery Funding Board funds.

TOTAL

For informational purposes, the total cost of the project is estimated between \$600,000 and \$750,000.

PRE-BID MEETING

DELIVERY OF BIDS

Bidders are cautioned that delivery service to San Juan Island is subject to delays due to inclement weather and ferry service disruptions. Bidders must allow adequate time for delivery of bids. Sealed Bid Packets shall be marked on the outside "POINT LAWRENCE ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT". Bids received after **1:00 p.m. on March 22, 2011**, will be unopened and returned.

Bidders who send their bids to San Juan County via USPS, Fed Ex, UPS, or other carrier shall place their bids in a sealed envelope, inside the carrier's envelope, to ensure that a sealed bid is received by the County.

Proposals are to be submitted only on the form provided with the Specifications. All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish a satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the Specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to San Juan County.
