

ORDINANCE NO. _____ - 2012

**REPEALING SAN JUAN COUNTY PRECINCTS IN SAN JUAN COUNTY CODE
CHAPTER 1.08 AND ADOPTING NINETEEN NEW VOTING PRECINCTS**

BACKGROUND

- A. The County Council adopted a redistricting plan for the County Council in October of 2011 (Ordinance 23-2011) in accordance with state law and 2010 census data.
- B. Precinct boundaries must be adopted by the county legislative body (RCW 29A.16.040). Because precinct boundaries may not cross district boundaries and the new districts necessitate new precincts.
- C. The County Elections Office has proposed new precincts for election administration, and submitted them to the County Council for adoption.
- D. The County conducted a duly advertised public hearing and has received public testimony.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Council of San Juan County, state of Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The existing precincts described in Chapter 1.08 of the San Juan County Code are repealed and replaced by the Precincts set forth in the following section 2 through section 20.

Section 2. Voting precinct No. 11 – San Juan Southeast. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 11, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island lying Easterly of the following described line:

Commencing at the intersection of the most Southerly corner of Lot 22 of the Plat of Eagle Cove Addition, recorded in Volume 2 of Long Plats, Page 7, records of San Juan County, Washington with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the West Shore of San Juan Island; Thence Northwesterly along the South boundary line of said Lot 22 to the most Westerly corner of said Lot 22; Thence Northeasterly along the West boundary line of said Lot 22 to the most Northerly corner of said Lot 22; Thence Southeasterly along the North boundary line of said Lot 22 to the intersection of said boundary line with the centerline of Eagle Cove Drive, a County Road; Thence Northeasterly along the centerline of Eagle Cove Drive to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Cattle Point Road, a County Road; Thence Northwesterly along the centerline of Cattle Point Road to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Madden Lane, a County Road; Thence Northwesterly along the centerline of Madden Lane to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Douglas Road, a County Road; Thence Northerly along the centerline of Douglas Road to its intersection of said centerline with the North boundary line of Section 22, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along said North boundary line to the Northeast Corner of said Section 22, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 23, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 23 to the North Quarter Corner of said Section 23; Thence Southerly along the Quarter Section line of said Section 23 to its intersection with the centerline of Shelter Road, a Private Road; Thence Southeasterly along said centerline of Shelter Road to its intersection of said centerline with the

centerline of Cattle Point Road, a County Road; Thence Northerly along the centerline of Cattle Point Road to its intersection with the North boundary line of said Section 23; Thence Easterly along said North boundary line of Section 23 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 23; Thence Southerly along the East boundary line of said Section 23 to its intersection with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the East Shore of San Juan Island and the end of said line.

TOGETHER WITH the following Outer Islands: Dinner Island, and Goose Island.

Section 3. Voting precinct No. 12 – San Juan Southwest. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 12, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island lying Southwesterly of the following described line:

Commencing at the intersection of the most Southerly corner of Lot 22 of the Plat of Eagle Cove Addition, recorded in Volume 2 of Long Plats, Page 7, records of San Juan County, Washington with the NOAA depicted shoreline along the West Shore of San Juan Island; Thence Northwesterly along the South boundary line of said Lot 22 to the most Westerly corner of said Lot 22; Thence Northeasterly along the West boundary line of said Lot 22 to the most Northerly corner of said Lot 22; Thence Southeasterly along the North boundary line of said Lot 22 to the intersection of said boundary line with the centerline of Eagle Cove Drive, a County Road; Thence Northeasterly along said centerline of Eagle Cove Drive to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Cattle Point Road, a County Road; Thence Northwesterly along the centerline of Cattle Point Road to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Madden Lane, a County Road; Thence Northwesterly along the centerline of Madden Lane to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Douglas Road, a County Road; Thence Southerly along the centerline of Douglas Road to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Bailer Hill Road, a County Road; Thence Westerly along the centerline of Bailer Hill Road to its intersection with the East boundary line of Section 30, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along said East boundary line of Section 30 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 30; Thence Westerly along the North boundary line of said Section 30 to the Northwest Corner of said Section 30, which is also the Southeast Corner of Section 24, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Westerly along the South boundary line of said Section 24 to its intersection with the centerline of West Side Road, a County Road; Thence Northwesterly along said centerline of West Side Road to its intersection with the West boundary line of Section 24; thence Southerly along said West boundary line of Section 24 to its intersection with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the West Shore of San Juan Island, and the end of said line.

Section 4. Voting precinct No. 13 – San Juan Central. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 13, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the Southeast Meander Corner common to Sections 23 and 24, Township 35 North, Range 4 West of W.M. with the NOAA depicted shoreline along the West Shore of San Juan Island; Thence Northerly along the West boundary line of said Section 24 to its intersection with the centerline of West Side Road and THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; Thence continuing Northerly along said West boundary line of Section 24 to the Northwest Corner

of said Section 24, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 13, Township 35 North, Range 4 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along the West boundary line of said Section 13 to the Northwest Corner of said Section 13, which also the Southwest Corner of Section 12, Township 35 North, Range 4 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along the West boundary line of said Section 12 to the Northwest Corner of said Section 12; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 12 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 12, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 7, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 7 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 7, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 8, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 8 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 8, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 9, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 9 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 9, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 10, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 10 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 10; Thence Southerly along the East boundary line of said Section 10 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 10, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 11, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 11 to its intersection with the external boundary line of the Town of Friday Harbor; Thence Southerly along said external boundary line of the Town to its intersection with the South Quarter Corner of said Section 14 and the end of said line; Thence Westerly along the South boundary line of said Section 14 to the Southwest Corner of said Section 14, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 22, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Westerly along the North boundary line of said Section 22 to its intersection with the centerline of Douglas Road, a County Road; Thence Southerly along said centerline of Douglas Road to its intersection with the centerline of Bailer Hill Road, a County Road; Thence Westerly along said centerline of Bailer Hill Road to its intersection with the East boundary line of Section 30, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along said East boundary line to the Northeast Corner of said Section 30; Thence Westerly along the North boundary line of said Section 30 to the Northwest Corner of said Section 30, which is also the Southeast Corner of Section 24, Township 35 North, Range 4 West of W.M.; Thence Westerly along the South boundary line of said Section 24 to its intersection with the centerline of West Side Road, a County Road; Thence Northwesterly along said centerline of West Side Road to its intersection with the West boundary line of Section 24 and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Section 5. Voting precinct No. 14 – San Juan West. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 14, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island lying Southerly of Horseshoe Bay and Westcott Bay, and all that portion of San Juan Island lying Southerly of the following described line:

Commencing at the intersection of the Southwest Meander Corner of Section 24, Township 36 North, Range 4 West of W.M. with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the West Shore of San Juan Island; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 24 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 24, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 19, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 19 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 19, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 20, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 20

to the intersection of Southeast Meander Corner of said Section 20 extended to its intersection with the NOAA depicted shoreline along the East Shore of San Juan Island and the end of said line;

EXCEPT THEREFROM all that portion of San Juan Island lying Southeasterly of the following described line:

Commencing at the intersection of the Southeast Meander Corner of Section 23, Township 35 North, Range 4 West of W.M. with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the West Shore of San Juan Island; Thence Northerly along the East boundary line of said Section 23 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 23, which is also the Southeast Corner of Section 14, Township 35 North, Range 4 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along the East boundary line of said Section 14 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 14, which also the Southeast Corner of Section 11, Township 35 North, Range 4 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along the East boundary line of said Section 11 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 11, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 12, Township 35 North, Range 4 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 12 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 12, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 7, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 7 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 7, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 8, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 8 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 8, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 5, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along the East boundary line of said Section 5 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 5, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 32, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along the East boundary line of said Section 32 to the Northeast Corner of said Section 32, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 29, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along the East boundary line of said Section 29 to its intersection with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the East Shore of San Juan Island and the end of said line.

Section 6. Voting precinct No. 15 – San Juan North. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 15, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island lying Northerly of Horseshoe Bay and Westcott Bay, and all that portion of San Juan Island lying Northerly of the following described line:

Commencing at the intersection of the Southwest Meander Corner of Section 24, Township 36 North, Range 4 West of W.M. with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the West Shore of San Juan Island; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 24 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 24, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 19, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 19 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 19, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 20, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 20 to the intersection of Southeast Meander Corner of said Section 20 extended to its intersection with the NOAA depicted shoreline along the East Shore of San Juan Island and the end of said line;

TOGETHER WITH the following Outer Islands: Henry Island, O’Neal Island, Battleship Island, Pearl Island, Posey Island, Barren Island, Flattop Island, Spieden Island, Sentinel Island, Cactus

Islands, Ripple Island, Johns Island, Stuart Island, Satellite Island, Cemetery Island, and Gossip Island.

Section 7. Voting precinct No. 16 – San Juan East. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 16, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island lying Northwesterly of the following described line:

Commencing at the intersection of the North Meander Corner common to Sections 28 and 29, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M. with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the East Shore of San Juan Island; Thence Southerly from said Shoreline along the West boundary line of said Section 28 to the Southwest Corner of said Section 28, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 33, Township 36 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Southerly along the West boundary line of said Section 33 to the Southwest Corner of said Section 33, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 4, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Southerly along the West boundary line of said Section 4 to the Southwest Corner of said Section 4; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 4 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 4, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 3, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 3 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 3, which is also the Northwest Corner of Section 11, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Southerly along the West boundary line of said Section 11 to the Southwest Corner of said Section 11; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 11 to its intersection with the external boundary line of the Town of Friday Harbor; Thence Northerly and Easterly along said external boundary line of said Town continuing along said external boundary line to its intersection with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the East Shore of San Juan Island and the end of said line.

Section 8. Voting precinct No. 17 – Turn Point. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 17, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island bounded Easterly of the following described line:

Commencing at the Northeast Corner of Section 24, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Southerly along the West boundary line of said Section 24 to the intersection of said boundary line with the NOAA depicted shoreline along the East Shore of San Juan Island; Thence returning Northerly along said West boundary line of said Section 24 to said Northwest Corner of said Section 24, which is also the Northeast Corner of Section 23, Township 35 North, Range 3 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section 23 to the intersection of the centerline of Cattle Point Road, a County Road; Thence Southerly along said centerline of Cattle Point Road to the intersection of the centerline of Shelter Road, a Private Road; Thence Westerly and Northerly along said centerline of Shelter Road to the intersection of said centerline with the West boundary line of the East half of said Section 23; Thence Northerly along said West boundary line to the intersection of the North boundary line of said Section 23 which is also a point along the external boundary line of the Town of Friday Harbor; Thence Easterly from said point on

said external boundary line of Town of Friday Harbor and continuing along said external boundary line of the Town of Friday Harbor to its intersection with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the East Shore of San Juan Island, and the end of said line;

TOGETHER WITH the following Outer Islands: Brown Island, Turn Island, and Reef Point Island.

Section 9. Voting precinct No. 21 – Waldron and Outer Islands. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 21, legally described as:

Waldron Island and the following Outer Islands: Patos Island, Skipjack Island, James Island, Yellow Island, Low Island, Cliff Island, Nob Island, McConnell Island, Coon Island, Reef Island, Crane Island, Fawn Island, and Bell Island.

Section 10. Voting precinct No. 22 – Orcas West. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 22, legally described as:

All that portion of Orcas Island lying Westerly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the extended centerline of North Beach Road, a County Road, and the NOAA depicted shoreline for Orcas Island along Fishing Bay in the East Sound; Thence northerly along said extended centerline to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Main Street, a County Road; Thence Westerly along said Main Street centerline to its intersection with the centerline of Lover's Lane, a County Road; Thence Northerly along said Lover's Lane centerline to its intersection with the centerline of Enchanted Forest Road, a County Road; Thence Easterly along said Enchanted Forest Road centerline to its intersection with the centerline of North Beach Road, a County Road; Thence Northerly along said centerline of North Beach Road to its intersection with the centerline of Mount Baker Road, a County Road; Thence Westerly along said centerline of Mount Baker Road to its intersection with the centerline of Lover's Lane, a County Road; Thence proceeding Westerly along said centerline of Mount Baker Road to its intersection with the centerline of Blanchard Road, a County Road; Thence Northerly along said centerline of Blanchard Road to its apparent intersection with the South boundary line of Government Lot 4 of Section 11, Township 37 North, Range 2 West, W.M.; Thence Westerly along said Government Lot 4 South boundary line to the Southwest Corner of Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 271123003; Thence Northerly along the West line of said Parcel to the Northwest Corner of said Parcel; Thence Northerly in a straight line to the Southwest Corner of APN 271123002; Thence Northerly along the West line of APN 271123002 to its intersection with the Southeast Corner of APN 271123013; Thence Westerly along the Common South Line of Assessor Parcel Numbers 271123013, 271123004, 271123005, 271123006 and 271123007 to the Southwest Corner of APN 271123007; Thence Northerly along the West line of APN 271123007 to its intersection with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the North Shore of Orcas Island and the end of said line.

TOGETHER WITH the following Outer Islands: Big Double Island, Little Double Island, Victim Island, and Skull Island.

EXCEPT THEREFROM all that portion of Orcas Island lying Southerly and Easterly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the extended centerline of North Beach Road, a County Road, and the NOAA depicted shoreline for Orcas Island along Fishing Bay in the East Sound; Thence Northerly along said extended centerline to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Main Street, a County Road; Thence Westerly along the said centerline Main Street to the centerline of its intersection of said centerline with Orcas Road, a County Road; Thence Southwesterly along said centerline of Orcas Road to the centerline of its intersection of said centerline with Crow Valley Road, a County Road; Thence Southwesterly along said centerline of Crow Valley Road to its intersection of said centerline with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along West Sound of Orcas Island and the end of said line.

Section 11. Voting precinct No. 23 – Orcas Central. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 23, legally described as:

All that portion of Orcas Island lying Southerly and Westerly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the extended centerline of North Beach Road, a County Road, and the NOAA depicted shoreline for Orcas Island along Fishing Bay in the East Sound; Thence Northerly along said extended centerline to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Main Street, a County Road; Thence Westerly along said centerline of Main Street to its intersection with the centerline of Lover's Lane, a County Road; Thence Northerly along said Lane centerline to its intersection with the centerline of Enchanted Forest Road, a County Road; Thence Easterly along said Road centerline to its intersection with the centerline of North Beach Road, a County Road; Thence Northerly along the centerline of North Beach Road to its intersection with the centerline of Mount Baker Road, a County Road; Thence Westerly along the centerline of Mount Baker Road to its intersection with the centerline of Lover's Lane, a County Road; Thence proceeding Westerly along the centerline of Mount Baker Road to its intersection with the centerline of Blanchard Road, a County Road; Thence Northerly along the centerline of Blanchard Road to its apparent intersection with the South Line of Government Lot 4 of Section 11, Township 37 North, Range 2 West, W.M.; Thence Westerly along said Government Lot 4 South boundary line to the Southwest Corner of Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 271123003; Thence Northerly along the West line of said Parcel to the Northwest Corner of said Parcel; Thence Northerly in a straight line to the Southwest Corner of APN 271123002; Thence Northerly along the West line of APN 271123002 to its intersection with the Southeast Corner of APN 271123013; Thence Westerly along the Common South line of Assessor Parcel Numbers 271123013, 271123004, 271123005, 271123006 and 271123007 to the Southwest Corner of APN 271123007; Thence northerly along the West line of APN 271123007 to its intersection with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along the North Shore of Orcas Island and the end of said line.

TOGETHER WITH the following Outer Islands: Indian Island, Twin Rocks, Oak Island, and Picnic Island.

EXCEPT THEREFROM all that portion of Orcas Island lying Northerly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the extended centerline of North Beach Road, a County Road, and the NOAA depicted shoreline for Orcas Island along Fishing Bay in the East Sound; Thence Northerly along said extended centerline to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Main Street, a County Road; Thence Westerly along the centerline Main Street to the centerline of its intersection of said centerline with Orcas Road, a County Road;

EXCEPT THEREFROM all that portion of Orcas Island lying Northwesterly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline Main Street, a County Road with the centerline of Orcas Road, a County Road; Thence Southwesterly along said centerline of Orcas Road to the centerline of its intersection of said centerline with Crow Valley Road, a County Road; Thence Southwesterly along said centerline of Crow Valley Road to its intersection of said centerline with the NOAA depicted Shoreline along West Sound Shore of Orcas Island and the end of said line.

Section 12. Voting precinct No. 24 – Eastsound. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 24, legally described as:

All that portion of Orcas Island lying Northerly of the following described line:

Commencing at the most Westerly Quarter Corner between the North half and South half of Section 25, Township 37 North, Range 2 West of W.M. and its intersection with the NOAA depicted shoreline along the East Shore of East Sound; Thence from said intersection Easterly along the South boundary of said North half of Section 25 to the East Quarter Corner of said Section 25, which is also the West Quarter Corner of Section 30, Township 37 North, Range 1 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary of the North half of said Section 30 to the East Quarter Corner of said Section 30, which is also the West Quarter Corner of Section 29, Township 37 North, Range 1 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary of the North half of said Section 29 to the East Quarter Corner of said Section 29, which is also the West Quarter Corner of Section 28, Township 37 North, Range 1 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary of the North half of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 28 to the Center Section Corner of said Section 28; Thence Northerly along North/South centerline of said Section 28 to the North Quarter Corner of said Section 28, which also the South Quarter Corner of Section 21, Township 37 North, Range 1 West of W.M.; Thence Northerly along the North/South centerline of said Section 21 to the Center Section Corner of said Section 21; Thence Easterly along the East/West centerline of said Section 21 to the East Quarter Corner of said Section 21, which is also the West Quarter Corner of Section 22, Township 37 North, Range 1 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the East/West centerline of said Section 22 to the most Easterly Quarter Corner of said Section 22 and the end of said line;

EXCEPT THEREFROM all that portion of Orcas Island lying Westerly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the extended centerline of North Beach Road, a County Road, and the NOAA depicted shoreline for Orcas Island along Fishing Bay in the East Sound; Thence Northerly along said extended centerline to its intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Main Street, a County Road; Thence Westerly along said Main Street centerline to its intersection

Section 15. Voting precinct No. 31 – Lopez North. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 31, legally described as:

All that portion of Lopez Island lying Northerly of the following described line:

Commencing at the Westerly Meander Corner common to Sections 28 and 33 Township 35 North, Range 2 West of W.M., and its intersection with the depicted NOAA shoreline along the West Shore of Lopez Island; Thence Easterly from said shoreline along the South boundary of said Section 28 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 28, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 27, Township 35 North, Range 2 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary of said Section 27 to the centerline of Fisherman Bay Road, a County Road; Thence Northwesterly along said centerline of Fisherman Bay Road to the North boundary line of the South half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 27; Thence Easterly along said North boundary line to the East boundary line of said Section 27, which also the West boundary line of Section 26, Township 35 North, Range 2 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of the South half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 26 to the centerline of Center Road, a County Road; Thence South along said centerline of Center Road to the South boundary line of said Section 26; Thence Easterly along said South boundary line to the Southeast Corner of said Section 26, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 25, Township 35 North, Range 2 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary line of said Section 25 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 25, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 30, Township 35 North, Range 1 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly on the South boundary line of said Section 30 to the Southeast Meander Corner of said Section 30 and its extension to the depicted NOAA shoreline along the East Shore of Lopez Island and the end of said line.

Commencing at the Westerly Meander Corner common to Sections 28 and 33 Township 35 North, Range 2 West of W.M., and its intersection with the depicted NOAA shoreline along the West Shore of Lopez Island; Thence Easterly from said shoreline along the South boundary of said Section 28 to the Southeast Corner of said Section 28, which is also the Southwest Corner of Section 27, Township 35 North, Range 2 West of W.M.; Thence Easterly along the South boundary of said Section 27 to the centerline of Fisherman Bay Road, a County Road; Thence Northwesterly along said centerline of Fisherman Bay Road to the North boundary line of the South half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 27; Thence Easterly along said North boundary line to the East boundary line of said Section 27, which also the West boundary line of Section 26, Township 35

Decatur Island and the following Outer Islands: Center Island, James Island, Ram Island, Reads Bay Island, Rim Island, Rum Island, Trump Island, Boulder Island, Colville Islands, Castle Island, Blind Island (south of Lopez), Swirl Islands, Iceberg Island, Hall Island, Secar Island, Charles Island, Long Islands, Buck Island, Mummy Island, Whale Rocks, and Deadman Islands.

Section 18. Voting precinct No. 41 – Shaw. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 41, legally described as:

Shaw Island together with the following Outer Islands: Canoe Island, and Blind Island (Northeast of Shaw Island).

Section 19. Voting precinct No. 101 – Friday Harbor North. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 26, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island located within the boundary of the Town of Friday Harbor lying Northwesterly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the extended centerline of Spring Street, a Town Road, and the NOAA depicted shoreline for San Juan Island on the East Shore of San Juan Island; Thence Southwesterly along said centerline of Spring Street to its intersection of said centerline with the most Westerly boundary line of the Town of Friday Harbor.

Section 20. Voting precinct No. 102 – Friday Harbor South. There is established San Juan County voting precinct No. 102, legally described as:

All that portion of San Juan Island located within the boundary of the Town of Friday Harbor lying Northwesterly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the extended centerline of Spring Street, a Town Road, and the NOAA depicted shoreline for San Juan Island on the East Shore of San Juan Island; Thence

Southwesterly along said centerline of Spring Street to its intersection of said centerline with the most Westerly boundary line of the Town of Friday Harbor.

Section 21. Official Maps. There is hereby adopted and approved as Attachment 1, Attachment 2 and Attachment 3 the official maps of the precincts described in Section 2 through 10 of this Ordinance.

Section 22. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect April 1, 2012.

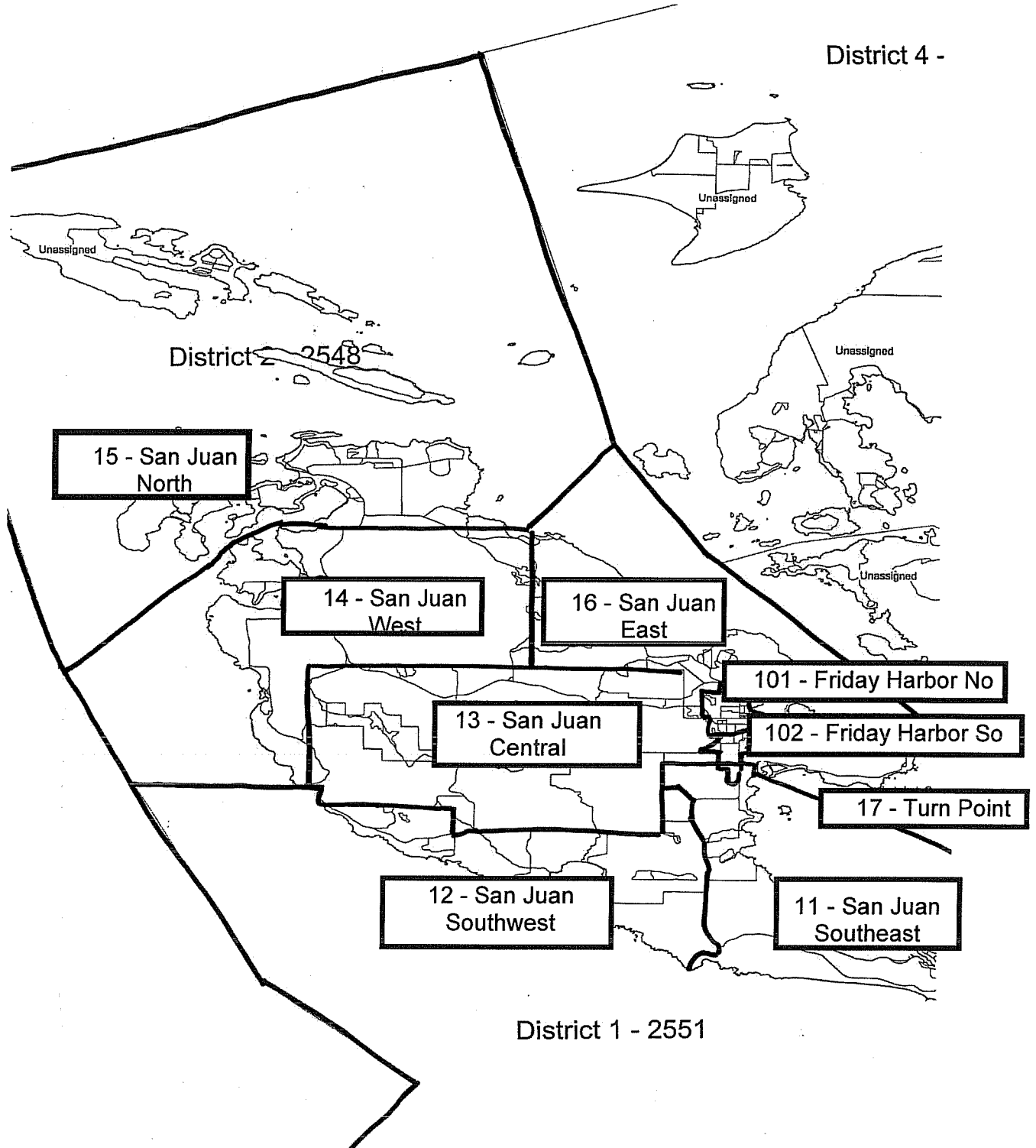

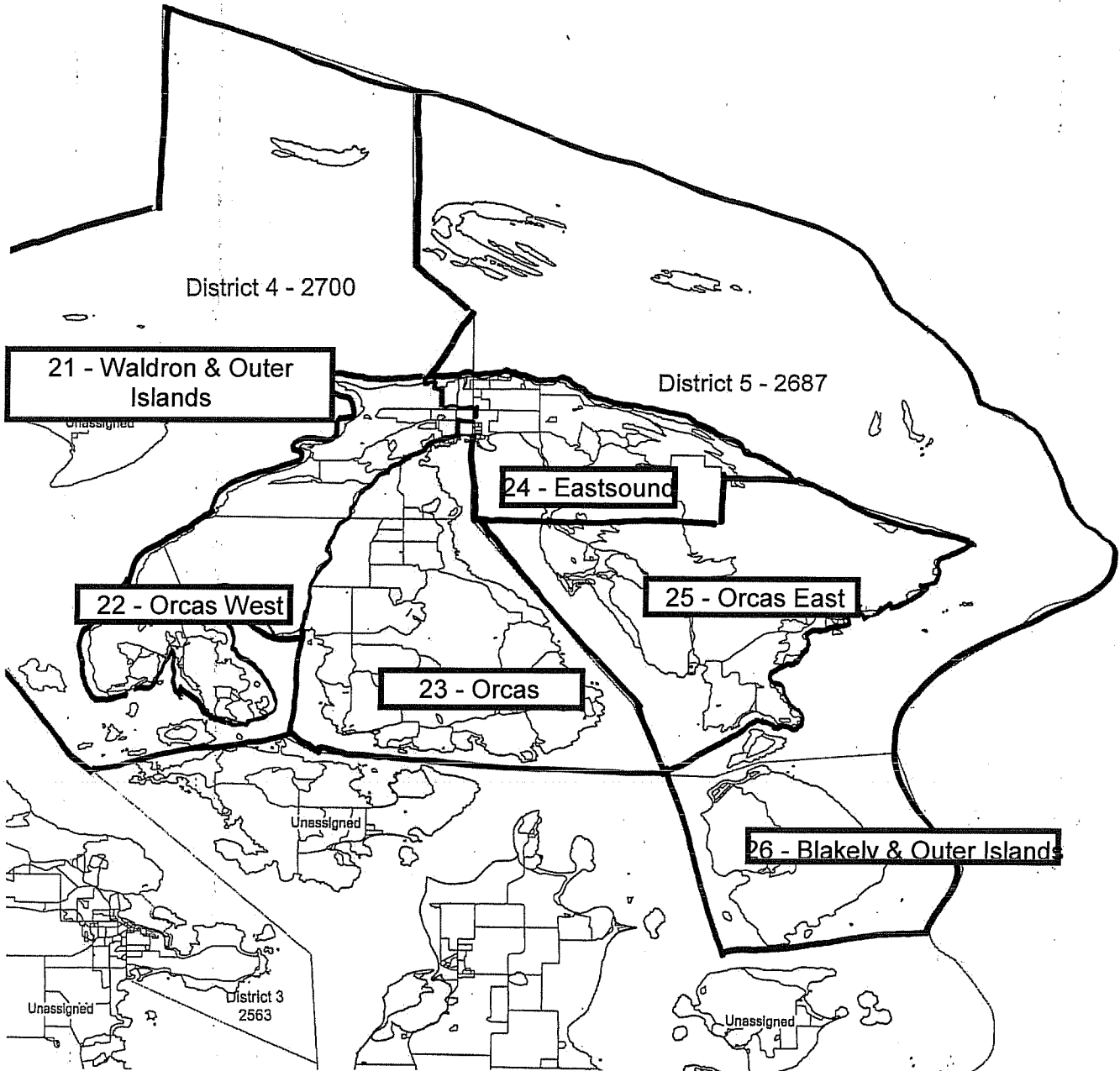
