<b>DON'T BRING</b>	Unlabeled containers! Latex Paint (ORS accepts or dry out), Lead acid batteries, propane tanks, & E-waste (Solid Waste Stations accept), Fluorescent tubes & bulbs (take to OPALCO, SJ Ace Hardware, LSWDD, ORS), Flares, Explosives, Ammunition
