1. THIS STANDARD APPLIES TO ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE NAMED ROADS PER SJCC SEC. 15.08.040.
2. ALL SIGNS SHALL COMPLY WITH THE STANDARDS, OPTIONS AND GUIDANCE IN THE CURRENT MUTCD, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY STATED OTHERWISE.
3. WITHIN LOPEZ VILLAGE AND EASTSOUND URBAN GROWTH AREAS (UGAs), ALL STREET NAME SIGNS SHALL BE MOUNTED ABOVE STOP SIGNS.
4. DEAD END AND NO OUTLET PLAQUES SHALL BE MOUNTED DIRECTLY BELOW THE STREET NAME SIGN THAT IT SUPPLEMENTS.
5. WHENEVER POSSIBLE, SIGNS SHALL BE CENTER MOUNTED ON TOP OF A POST WITH A BRACKET USING THEFT RESISTANT HARDWARE.
