



NOTES

1. SIGNS SHALL BE INSTALLED ABOVE A STOP SIGN. WHEN THERE ARE MULTIPLE STOP SIGNS, SIGNS SHALL BE INSTALLED ABOVE THE STOP SIGN WITH THE BEST VISIBILITY TO TRAFFIC APPROACHING FROM ALL DIRECTIONS.
2. SIGNS SHALL BE INSTALLED ON A SINGLE POST AT EACH INTERSECTION. HOWEVER, NO MORE THAN THREE STREET NAME SIGNS MAY BE INSTALLED ON A SINGLE POST.
3. WHEN IT IS NECESSARY TO USE A SEPARATE POST, THE POST SHALL BE LOCATED WHERE THE VISIBILITY IS BEST TO TRAFFIC APPROACHING FROM ALL DIRECTIONS.
4. LONGITUDINAL LOCATION OF STOP SIGN SHALL BE WHERE EDGE OF PAVEMENT RADIUS MEETS TANGENT TO ROADWAY TRAVEL LANE.
5. WHEN PRIMARY AND SECONDARY ROADS ARE PUBLIC, SIGN BOTH ROADS. HOWEVER, WHEN PRIMARY ROAD IS PUBLIC AND SECONDARY ROAD IS PRIVATE, ONLY SIGN SECONDARY ROAD.
