P4. Line 5 – “of occasional or recreational use second homes” clunky and confusing

Line 11- “vacant”

p. 5 line 13 – start the sentence with 84 %

Line 15 needs “.”

p.g 6 line 29 – Units refers to housing is there another word? Communities; hamlets

line 37 – change the to “this”

line 39 – drop “The” at end of the line

line 41 sentence beginning with “The ACS isto end of line 45” she is suggests it is not necessary unless you describe all of the data sources.

More general comment – be consistent with numbers either write them out or use numerals – not both. I was always from the school that you wrote out numbers through nine and after that used the numeral. I am sure you probably have a larger style sheet you are following.

p. 7 line 26 change thirty – six to “36”

line 43 and 44 changes words to numbers 50 and 50

p. 8 line 2 should that be Table 5-1?

Line 3 – change words to numbers

Line 4 citation – should that be a foot note

Line 16, 17, 18 and 19 change words to numbers

p. 9 line 1 Are you referring to table 5-1 or 5 – 2. She found it confusing you refer to one number in the narrative and labeled the table on that page differently.

Line 19-21..."it is estimated....urban growth areas" duplicative content from another page....if this is the summary perhaps it needs to be set off or stylized in a box..

I think she only got to this point.
