Please delete the words "both" and "and Countywide" from the Proposed Comp Plan Revision Amendments (<https://www.sanjuanco.com/DocumentCenter/View/14542>) leaving the Recycling, solid waste, and sewage treatment managed within the confines of each island. We have our own sewage treatment district and do not like our local government. Consolidating the districts into the central government gives the opportunity for mismanagement by a corrupt few. Please do not allow this consolidation to occur.

Also, please do not take upon the responsibility of providing water for everyone in the islands. This is not the county's job, it is the citizens who move into a rural area to provide for their own water. The city of Friday Harbor is given this task, but the county is not. Please delete the new proposed Comp Plan words "Conserved as a vital resource (under "Basic Human Needs)," and "Drinking water resources are managed to meet the needs of our community and natural environment (in Energy and Resources)."

Also, please eliminate "enacting incentives and regulations to reduce our carbon footprint. Greenhouse gas emissions are limited." This is vague terminology that would open a whole Pandora's box of unnecessary regulation in our beautifully pristine islands. Please do not add this language.
