- Our water supply is at a critical juncture, with hotter summers and at the same time, greater demand. It is essential that we quantify and monitor our water supply.
- Our homes should be constructed with energy efficiency and low impact development criteria.
- The natural environment definition must include the marine waters, seeing as how there are more than twice as much square miles of marine water than land.
- The section on agriculture is great. A similar section on forestry needs to be added. (There are more forestry resource lands in SJC than agriculture resource lands.)
- I support the inclusion of climate change in the vision statement. I profoundly feel that similar consideration of climate change must be included in all elements of the comprehensive plan. This is important for responsible fiscal planning.
- Mental health and victim services should be specified, as well as elder and child care.
