Many of our neighbors, like us, have been here for over 30 years and don't believe our properties are appropriate for a marijuana grow operation, especially with our homes in such close approximation to his narrow property. The smell emanating from the processing of the marijuana and the intrusion of the noise and lights from the required security for such a property offer addition reasons why this property should not be permitted to grow marijuana.
