I looked at the second draft and noticed that libraries are not mentioned. Considering the the SJIL appears to own real property and is considering a major capita investment within the projected timeline, I thought I'd ask about this.

I notice that this does not include roads (transportation capital asset) though it does include marine capital assets which are also transportation capital assets. I'm sure this is no accident as I'm aware that to some extent, roads are separately supported.
