FIELD WORK CONTINUES FOR THE AGATE BEACH COUNTY PARK ROAD RELOCATION PROJECT

With the Governor's easing of restrictions for public works projects in this phase of the COVID-19 response, field work has resumed for the Agate Beach County Park Road Relocation Project.



Surveying for the preliminary road design was completed in February.

The next stage of field work involves collecting information to evaluate critical areas required to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act. Consultants for the Federal Highway Administration-Western Federal Lands (FHWA-WFL) will be onsite in mid/late May to complete a biological evaluation, delineate the wetlands in the project area, and conduct a cultural survey. FHWA-WFL is coordinating activities with the tribal communities.




This summer, public input will be solicited for park amenities, such as parking and signage, in coordination with the preliminary road design.

In a separate, but related effort, the Shoreline Restoration Project is continuing with the design phase and seeking construction funding through the state Salmon Recovery Grant program. A separate newsletter for this project will be sent out shortly.

Both projects are now estimated to be constructed in 2023.

This project will provide long-term access to public lands and residences south of Agate Beach County Park.
