Please remove establishment of International Ports of Entry on Orcas and Lopez Islands as goals in the Draft Comprehensive Plan.

The text is found in both Section 6.2.B and Section 6.3.A.

I oppose additional international ports of entry on Orcas and Lopez Islands because of the additional expenses for creating and sustaining such international ports.

We already have an adequate international port of entry in Friday Harbor. Adding these two additional international ports of entry on Orcas and Lopez would cause unwarranted additional public expenditures which are badly needed for other purposes.

The additional ports would also exacerbate the over-tourism problems we are trying to address responsibly as a community. Moreover, we do not need the increased air traffic and noise levels that would disturb our fragile environment.
