As I read the WAC's cited in this presentation, I wonder if you would consider including a Growth Board decision which seems apropos to the Eastsound discussion. "While there is no precise requirement in the GMA to specifically identify locations of future industrial, commercial and/or residential growth, a general location of such urban growth must be included in a land capacity analysis. FOSC v. Skagit county 95-2-0009 (FDO, 8-30-95)".

Eastsound is located with ocean in two directions and sacred cows in the other two, constrained. Where there may be room to expand today, the opportunity may well be effectively foreclosed if the opportunity is not seized while it still offers. Thinking ahead is what planning is about.
