



NOTICE - PLEASE READ

Under Ordinance 75-1993, a vehicle with a valid, properly affixed Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) decal will be exempt from the RPZ parking prohibitions where there is an "EXCEPT BY PERMIT" sign. It does not exempt the vehicle from other parking restrictions or controls.

UNDERSTANDING/OBLIGATIONS

I will promptly affix the decal issued to me to the rear bumper OR lower portion of the rear window (windshield for convertibles) of the vehicle for which it was issued, in a place where it may be easily seen. I will remove the decal if the vehicle is sold or transferred to another. Should a decal be lost, I will report it to the Public Works Department, 360-370-0500, within five (5) business days. **I understand that my vehicle may not be left unattended for more than 21 days.** Vehicles will be subject to towing if the owner cannot be located. I also understand and agree to abide by the San Juan County Public Works Hunter Bay Restricted Parking Zone Policy.
