

POSTERS FOR BUSINESSES and OTHER PUBLIC SPACES

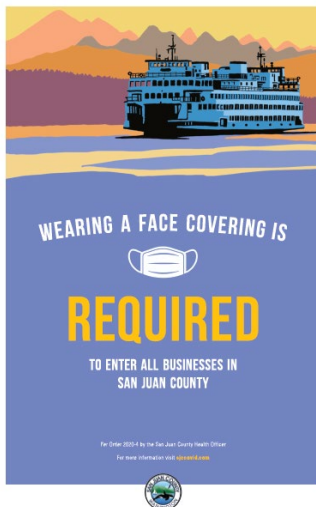
As per San Juan County Health Officer order 2020-4, all businesses and public indoor spaces are required to hang signage requiring the wearing of face coverings no later than 48 hours after San Juan County enters Phase 2.

This is critical for the health of our community, and it is important to communicate to both residents and visitors. Keeping the islands safe is vital to getting back on our feet and staying that way.

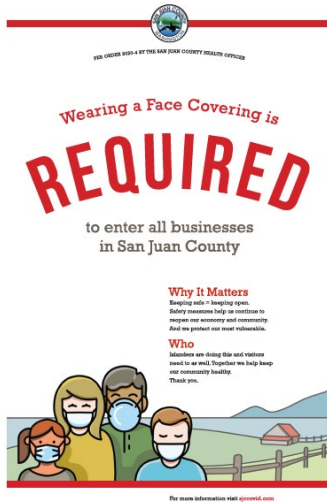
