**RESOLUTION <sup>27</sup>    -2020**

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE VOTERS OF  
LOPEZ SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL DISTRICT A PROPOSITION  
AUTHORIZING THE IMPOSITION OF A ONE YEAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY  
AS ALLOWED FOR BY RCW 36.58.150**

**Background**

- A. The Lopez Solid Waste Disposal District Managing Board has proposed to the Governing Board that the voters of the District be granted the choice to authorize an excess property tax levy for the year 2021 in the amount of \$105,000 for the purpose of providing revenue for operations of the District and to provide a mix of funding that provides a fair and stable way to pay for solid waste disposal for the residents and businesses on Lopez Island.
- B. RCW 36.58.150 authorizes the voters of a solid waste disposal district to levy property tax in excess of the one percent limitation, when authorized by the electors of the District pursuant to RCW 84.52.052 and Article VII, Section 2(a) of the Washington State Constitution.
- C. The proposal set out in this resolution requires approval by a three-fifths majority of the voters as required by Article VII, Section 2(a) of the State Constitution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Lopez Solid Waste Disposal District as follows:

1. The best interests of the citizens of Lopez Island require the submission to the qualified voters of the Lopez Solid Waste Disposal District a proposition to levy regular property taxes above the one percent limitation established in RCW 84.55.010, for approval or rejection at the general election to be held on November 3, 2020. The proposition shall be to impose an excess property tax levy for the year 2021 in the estimated amount of \$.08322 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for collection in 2021.
2. The excess levy, if approved by the voters, will generate \$105,000.00 of additional revenue for the year 2021, which funds, together with any increases thereto as authorized by RCW 84.55, shall be used to fund only the operating and capital expenses of the Lopez Solid Waste Disposal District.

3. The County Auditor, as supervisor of elections in San Juan County, Washington, is hereby requested to assume jurisdiction of, and to call and conduct a general election to be held within San Juan County and to submit to the qualified electors of the County the proposition set forth in this resolution.
4. The Prosecuting Attorney is requested to certify a proposition in substantially the following form:

The Governing Body of the Lopez Solid Waste Disposal District adopted Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_ concerning an excess levy for the District. This proposition would authorize the District to generate \$105,000 by a levy of excess taxes upon all taxable property within the District in an amount estimated to be \$.08322 cents per \$1,000 assessed valuation for one tax year -- 2021 -- for the purpose of funding operations and capital improvements of the District. 6. The Prosecuting Attorney shall prepare an Explanatory Statement based on this resolution for use in the Voters' Pamphlet.
7. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon adoption.
