ADDITIONAL FIELD WORK BEGINNING NEXT MONTH

The first phase of the cultural survey, the wetland delineation, and a biological evaluation were completed this summer. Copies of the environmental reports can be found on the Public Works website.

In early December, a geotechnical investigation and the second phase of the cultural survey will be conducted. The parking lot at the County Park will be closed for two days on December 3 and 4.

FHWA-WFL is coordinating activities with the tribal communities.



The preliminary (30%) design has been delayed while additional options related to the road alignment are explored further. A virtual public meeting will be held after the first of the year to share options with the community. A separate announcement will be sent out with the date.

The County has entered into an assistance agreement with the BLM to create a channel for funding support for visitor amenities at the park, such as wayfinding and interpretive signs, trail

building and maintenance, and possibly even a future ADA restroom.

In a separate, but related effort, the Shoreline Restoration Project is nearing completion with the design phase and is seeking construction funding through the state Salmon Recovery Grant program. A separate newsletter for this project will be sent out.

This project will provide long-term access to public lands and residences south of Agate Beach County Park.
