RESOLUTION NO. <u>03</u> - 2021

A RESOLUTION ENACTING A MORATORIUM ON VACATION RENTALS OF RESIDENCES OR ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS.

WHEREAS, San Juan County Code 18.40.275 regulates vacation rental of residences or accessory dwelling units;

WHEREAS, vacation rentals of residences or accessory dwelling units can have significant impacts on the community;

WHEREAS, the San Juan County Council desires to receive input from the community, recommendations from the Planning Commission and a proposed work plan from the Department of Community Development, and develop additional regulations for vacation rentals of residences or accessory dwelling units;

WHEREAS, the County Council determines that it is necessary to enact a moratorium on the issuance of vacation rental permits;

WHEREAS, the County Council will conduct a public hearing, within 60 days, on Tuesday, February 23, at 9:15 am regarding the moratorium; and

WHEREAS, this moratorium will be for a period not to exceed six months unless extended for good cause by ordinance at a later date;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of San Juan County, state of Washington, as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as findings of fact.
- 2. San Juan County does hereby adopt a six-month moratorium on the issuance of vacation rental permit processing, which shall expire unless renewed or otherwise extended as provided in RCW 36.70.795 and 36.70A.390.
- 3. While this moratorium is in effect, no new applications for a vacation rental permit shall be accepted as complete by any county department, and no currently pending incomplete application shall be accepted as complete by any county department.
- 4. This moratorium shall commence at 12:01 am on January 13, 2021.
