Dear Ms. Fritz,

Vacation Rental regulations were the single most talked about issue I encountered during my campaign. The County Council candidates were all repeatedly asked for opinions and action plans which were broadcast in public forums and printed in newspapers. I was approached by a wide swath of voters, most of them distressed about the negative effects of vacation rentals and many employed in the hospitality industry. I am acting according to the statements and promises I made.

To be clear, we are not considering a ban on vacation rentals, nor will the moratorium effect the operation of any vacation rentals currently permitted. The purpose of this moratorium on issuing new vacation rental permits is to give us time to gather facts and public input in order to find solutions the majority of islanders can live with. Thank you for the adding your voice to the discussion. I am forwarding your letter to the clerk to the County Council so it can become part of the record as public comment on the moratorium. Please note there will be a hearing on continuing the moratorium at the County Council meeting on Tuesday February 23rd.
