**How to vote**

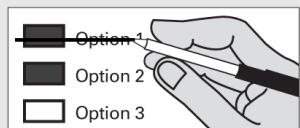


Use a dark blue or black ink pen to completely fill in the box to the left of your choice.

**San Juan Island Park & Recreation District**

**Proposition No. 1 - Levy**

The Board of Commissioners of the San Juan Island Park and Recreation District ("Island Rec") adopted Resolution No. 21-01 concerning the District's regular property tax levy. This proposition would authorize Island Rec to renew a property tax levy of 38.5 cents or less per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for each of the tax years 2022 - 2027, subject to the limit factors in RCW 84.55, which monies (or proportionate amount) will be dedicated for the following purposes:

16.5 cents for funding Island Rec programs and recreational services;

10.0 cents for sports programs with the School District; and

12.0 cents for operation and maintenance of all Island Rec parks, including John O. Linde Community Park.

**Orcas Island School District No. 137**

**Proposition No. 1 - Technology Capital Projects Levy**

The Board of Directors of Orcas Island School District No. 137 adopted Resolution No. 2021-01 concerning a facilities and technology modernization levy to meet the anticipated needs of the district. The proposition authorizes the modernization and remodeling of District facilities, including technology systems; and authorizes the following excess levies for such purposes on all taxable property within the District:
