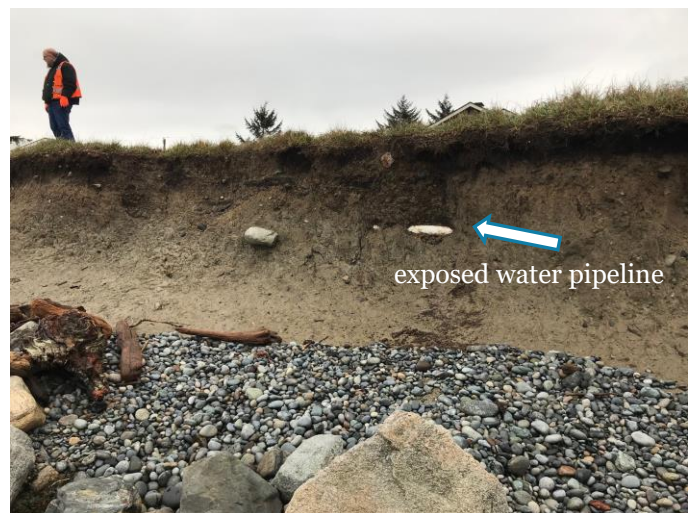

NEW ROAD ALIGNMENT TO BE EXPLORED

Based on the results of field work and current design issues, an alternate alignment for the beginning of the new road will be investigated in the next few months. Factors contributing to this decision include the extensive presence of cultural resources, challenges with bank stabilization permitting, and recent impacts to the shoreline from the past winter's storms.

Field work for the proposed northern extension will begin in the next month or two to assess the viability of the new alignment. It will take approximately six months to determine the feasibility of the northern extension



route. At that time, a public meeting will be held to present the information and discuss the road options.

In a separate, but related effort, the Shoreline Restoration Project was approved for construction funding through the state Salmon Recovery Funding Board program with funding available later this year. With this funding, a new permanent stairway will be constructed by the summer of 2022. The Shoreline Restoration Project will occur in the same season as the construction of the road relocation project.

This project will provide long-term access to public lands and residences that rely on MacKaye Harbor Road.
