Register to Vote

Online

Log in to votewa.gov to register to vote or update your address. You must have a Washington State driver's license, permit, or ID card. Online registrations must be submitted no later than July 26 in order to process the registration for the Primary Election.

In person

The Elections office is open for registration 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, M-F, and 8:00 am to 8:00 pm on Election Day, August 3. In person registrations must be initiated no later than 8:00 pm on Election Day, August 3.

By mail

Accessible Voting

San Juan County voters with disabilities have the option of voting independently and privately using an accessible voting unit.

The accessible voting equipment will be available Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, beginning Friday, July 16, through August 3, and from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm on Election Day, August 3.
