RE: Objection to Quarry MRLO Designation

Dear San Juan County Department of Community Development,

My husband and I are the property owners of 731 Spring Hill Road in the Spring Hill Sanctuary Community adjacent to the Dolphin Bay Quarry. We received a letter dated July 6, 2021 regarding Submitted Request for Designation under the Mineral Resource Land Overlay (MRLO) on July 9, 2021. This only provided us very short notice on researching and commenting on this proposal.

While we purchased the property in August of 2020 knowing that we share a property line with the Dolphin Bay Quarry we did not foresee expanded use of the quarry operations. We are concerned about relinquishing any rights that we may have to nuisance claims that are caused by the quarry operations. Additionally, expanding the quarry operations to include additional minerals may impact our wells, the wildlife and potentially our building site. Without understanding the environmental impact of the MRLO we urge you to reconsider this proposal and voice our objection.
