

# FISHERMAN BAY ROAD SHOULDER WIDENING



## TRAIL PROJECT COMPLETE FOR THE SEASON

As July draws to a close, the Fisherman Bay Road Trail construction is essentially complete until next spring.

The trail consists of a firm, 6 ft wide gravel walkway with a slight slope for drainage. Mailboxes have been moved where needed, and 'no parking' signs have been temporarily added in areas where vehicles tend to park.



A few items remain which will be completed over the next several months. Delineators and fencing will be added at the curve, midway along the trail. Soil was added to the slopes, and once the rains finally return this fall they will be seeded.

In the spring of 2022, an additional layer of gravel will be added in preparation for the the widened shoulder to be chipsealed. Pedestrian symbols will then be applied to the final trail surface.

Thank you again to all of the adjacent property owners that were supportive of the project and worked with the county to make this trail a reality.

***This project provides a wider travel corridor between Lopez Village and the marina for residents and visitors.***
