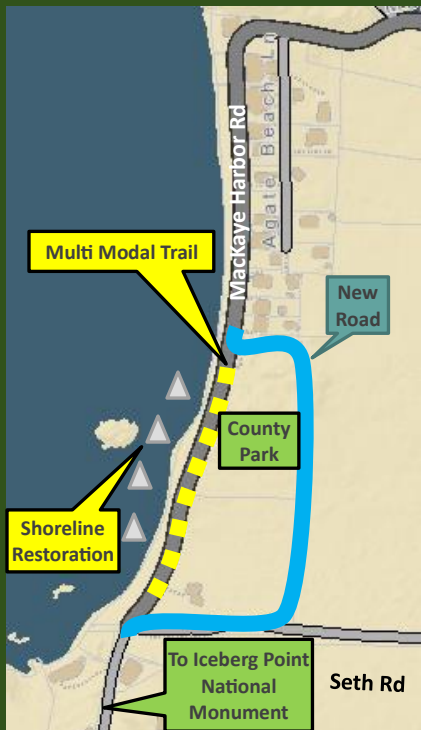


AGATE BEACH COUNTY PARK ROAD RELOCATION

FIELD WORK BEGINS ON THE PROPOSED RELOCATED ROAD PROJECT BEGINNING AT AGATE BEACH COUNTY PARK

Representatives from the Federal Highways/Western Federal Lands (FHWA-WFL), Bureau of Land Management and San Juan County toured the project site on December 2 to view the existing conditions in the park and surrounding area.



Surveying in advance of preliminary design has begun and will continue for the next month or so. This will include locating underground utilities in the area. Over the next six months, members of the county, FHWA-WFL, and their consultants may be seen in the area collecting information to evaluate critical areas required for the National Environmental Policy Act process.

Outreach to the tribes has been initiated and a cultural survey will take place in the spring. By summer, public input will be solicited for park amenities in coordination with the road preliminary design, such as parking and signage.

In a separate, but related effort, a restoration design is underway to remove the shoreline armoring boulders in front of the park to enhance forage fish spawning habitat.

This project will provide long-term access to public lands and residences south of Agate Beach County Park.
