FEASIBILITY EVALUATION OF NEW ROAD ALIGNMENT CONTINUES

San Juan County and the Federal Highways Administration (FHWA) continue to explore the feasibility of the new inland road alignment north of Agate Beach County Park. Last spring, the route for the beginning of the proposed new road was eliminated due to cultural, environmental and permitting issues. The subsequently proposed northern alignment extension would continue the inland relocation of MacKaye Harbor Road northward.

In the past six months, fieldwork along the northern alignment of the proposed road has taken place. The fieldwork has included cultural resources surveys, wetland delineation, and soils exploration. With the results of the data collected, the feasibility of the project will be determined and next steps defined.

This project will provide long-term access to all property owners that rely on MacKaye Harbor Road.
