



General Information

Welcome aboard Washington State Ferries. To ensure your trip is a safe and enjoyable one, please take a moment to read the following guidelines.

Understanding Our Schedule

Times in **color** are for morning (a.m.) departures and in black for afternoon/evening departures. Noon is noted as **12:00 a.m.** and one minute past noon as 12:01 p.m. Midnight is noted as 12:00 p.m. and one minute past midnight as **12:01 a.m.** The schedule is presented as a sailing day which begins with the first printed sailing time for that day and progresses consecutively through the last printed sailing time even though the last sailing may be past midnight and technically on the following day. Please pay special attention to annotations next to a sailing time.

Weekend or Holiday Schedules

The holiday schedule is in effect on May 25 for Point Defiance/Tahlequah, Seattle/Bainbridge Island, Edmonds/Kingston, and Mukilteo/Clinton. Extra service may be provided for holiday or special

event traffic on any of the routes. Please watch for notices on the vessels, at the terminals, or call one of the schedule information numbers.

Security

Security regulations require that all passengers and vehicles are subject to possible security screening. Additional security measures appear in the **Safety** and **Loading** sections.

Safety

Hazardous materials are not allowed aboard a state ferry on scheduled passenger trips except those in compliance with Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to, explosive or incendiary devices, chemical, biological, radiological agents or devices, unlawful or illegally possessed firearms, and illegal fireworks.

Gasoline may be transported in a vehicle in limited quantities up to 12 gallons total in portable containers, not to exceed 6 gallons maximum per container. Containers must be UL approved and in

good condition. All vehicles must have gas caps.

Regulations require that you shut off and tag all propane tanks prior to boarding, unless they are the primary fuel source for your vehicle. A limited number of portable propane tanks may be carried in a vehicle in addition to those installed in recreational vehicles. The total amount of propane shall not exceed 100 pounds (water equivalent) whether in a vehicle in a single 100-pound tank or multiple smaller tanks. All propane tanks must be secured and transported in a vehicle.

Transporting a combination of gasoline containers and propane tanks is very restricted. Please contact WSF Customer Service for detailed information.

Vehicle engines must be turned off while the vessel is underway. Do not restart your car until directed by a crew member.

Smoking is not allowed on WSF vessels. All smoking materials must be extinguished before boarding the vessel. No smoking is allowed within 25 feet of the entry to our ferry terminal facilities.

Loading

Unaccompanied vehicles, (vehicles without drivers), are not permitted.

Times listed in the schedule are departure times, unless otherwise noted. Vessels may cease loading 2 minutes in advance of sailing, except where noted. Walk-on passengers should be on board 5 minutes prior to departure time.

Vehicles are loaded in order of arrival with a few exceptions. However, vehicles that are over 7'6" tall or over 20' long, including those with tall antennas, may be loaded out of sequence and must pay a surcharge. Security requirements dictate that once loading has begun, the Captain's permission is required to disembark the vessel.

Vehicles should be in line at least 20 minutes prior to scheduled departure time. On some routes, vehicles must be moved frequently while in line. Please monitor your vehicle.

Bicyclists and persons carrying kayaks or canoes should wait near the front of the loading area, since they normally

load first. Once on board, secure bikes in the place provided. **Please Note:** On the passenger-only ferry, bicycle space is limited based on vessel size. Crews will direct passengers on placement of kayaks and canoes. When leaving the vessel, please watch for, and stay out of the way of, vehicles. Shoes with metal sports cleats are not permitted in passenger areas.

Animals, except service animals, are not allowed in terminal buildings or above the car decks, unless they are in a pet container. Contact terminal staff for loading procedures as vessel and terminal configurations vary. Animals that are not people-friendly should be muzzled or transported in a pet carrier.

Bridge Closure Information

The Hood Canal Bridge, which connects the Kitsap Peninsula with the Olympic Peninsula, is scheduled to be closed for construction beginning May 1, 2009 for six weeks. During the closure, passenger water shuttles will run between Lofall in Kitsap County and South Point in Jefferson County daily from 4:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. For water shuttle schedule information, visit www.wsdot.wa.gov/ferries or contact 1-877-595-4222.

There will also be one auto/passenger ferry making one round trip between Edmonds and Port Townsend Sunday through Thursday evening during the closure. The sailing will depart Edmonds at 8:40 p.m. arriving Port Townsend approximately 10:25 p.m. A return sailing will depart Port Townsend at 10:40 p.m., arriving Edmonds at approximately 12:25 a.m. Commercial customers should make reservations for these sailings by calling 1-888-808-7977 (WA & BC) or 511 (WA).

The regularly scheduled Edmonds-Kingston sailing times to the left with a box around them will be affected during the bridge closure. The 8:40 p.m. Edmonds sailing will be cancelled Sunday through Thursday to accommodate this sailing. Also the following Sunday sailings will be cancelled during the bridge closure: 10:00 p.m. and 11:20 p.m. sailings from Edmonds and the 9:20 p.m. and 10:40 p.m. sailings from Kingston.

Special Travel Notes: Anacortes / Sidney, BC Route

Travel to the San Juans: Vehicle space on the ferries is apportioned to each of the islands we serve, so ferries making additional island stops may depart with empty space. Peak travel times from Anacortes are Thursday and Friday afternoons and Saturday mornings. Peak travel times from the islands are Sunday all day and Monday mornings. Check our web site for up-to-date travel information.

International Reservations: Vehicle reservations are *recommended* for travel to or from Sidney, BC. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance by calling 206-464-6400 or 888-808-7977 (WA & BC).

International Travel: Visitors traveling to and from Canada are subject to inspection by U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Canadian Immigration, and Canadian Customs.

Beginning January 31, 2008, U.S. and Canadian citizens 19 years and older who enter the U.S. at land and sea ports of entry from within the Western Hemisphere will need to present

government issued photo ID, such as a driver's license as proof of identity, along with proof of citizenship, such as a birth certificate or naturalization certificate, or a passport. Children age 18 and under will be able to enter with proof of citizenship. Verbal claims of citizenship and identity alone will not be sufficient to establish identity and citizenship for entry into the United States.

If you are not a U.S. citizen, but are a permanent resident, you must have an alien resident green card. Children under the age of 18 not accompanied by an adult need proof of citizenship and a notarial letter from their parent or guardian giving permission to enter the U.S. or Canada.

Vehicles and baggage are subject to inspection. Articles you bring into either country are subject to being taxed.
