

General Information

Welcome aboard Washington State Ferries. To ensure your trip is a safe and enjoyable one, please take a moment to read the following ferry guidelines.

Understanding Our Schedule

Times in **color** are for morning (a.m.) departures and in black for afternoon/evening departures. Noon is noted as **12:00 a.m.** and one minute past noon as 12:01 p.m.; midnight is noted as 12:00 p.m. and one past midnight as **12:01 a.m.** The schedule is presented as a sailing day which begins with the first printed sailing time for that day and progresses consecutively through the last printed sailing time even though the last sailing may be past midnight and technically on the following day. Please pay special attention to annotations next to a sailing time.

Holiday Schedules

The holiday schedule is in effect on New Year's Day, Friday, December 31, for the Point Defiance/Tahlequah,

Seattle/Bainbridge Island, Edmonds/Kingston, and Mukilteo/Clinton routes.

Security

Security regulations require that all passengers and vehicles are subject to possible security screening. Additional security measures appear in the **Safety** and **Loading** sections.

Safety

Hazardous materials are not allowed aboard a state ferry on scheduled passenger trips except those in compliance with Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to explosive or incendiary devices, chemical, biological, radiological agents or devices, unlawful or illegally possessed firearms, and illegal fireworks.

Gasoline may be transported in limited quantities up to 12 gallons in portable containers, not to exceed six (6) gallons maximum per container. Containers must be UL or USCG approved and

in good condition. All vehicles must have gas caps.

Regulations require that you shut off and tag all propane tanks prior to boarding, unless they are the primary fuel source for your vehicle. A limited number of portable propane tanks may be carried in addition to those installed in recreational vehicles. The total amount of propane shall not exceed 100 pounds (approximately 25 gallons) whether in a single 100 pound tank or multiple smaller tanks. All propane tanks must be secured.

Vehicle engines must be turned off while the vessel is underway. Do not restart your car until directed by a crew member.

Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. No smoking is allowed on the car deck, in vehicles on the car deck, or on the pickleforks. All smoking materials must be extinguished during loading and unloading.

Loading

Unaccompanied vehicles (vehicles without drivers) are not permitted.

Times listed in the schedule are departure times unless otherwise noted. Vessels may cease loading three minutes in advance of sailing, except where noted.

Walk-on passengers should be on board five minutes prior to departure time.

Vehicles are loaded in order of arrival with a few exceptions. However, vehicles that are over height (7' 6") or over length (20'), including those with tall antennas, may be loaded out of sequence and must pay a surcharge. Security requirements dictate that once loading has begun, the Captain's permission is required to disembark the vessel.

Vehicles should be in line at least 20 minutes prior to scheduled departure time. On some routes, vehicles must be moved frequently while in line.

Bicyclists and persons carrying kayaks or canoes should wait near the front of the loading area, since they normally load first. Once on board, secure bikes in the place provided.

Animals, except service animals, are not allowed in terminal buildings or above the car decks, unless they are in a pet container.

Lost and Found

Please check that you have all your personal items before departing the ferry. If you should lose something, please contact 206-515-3439 for assistance.

Fares

A receipt will be issued for all sales. If a receipt is not issued, or if the receipt is different from what you paid, please send a description of the transaction to the address on the back of this schedule, Attn: Audit Office.

Cash, in-state checks, and travelers checks are accepted as payment. Major credit cards are also accepted, except at the San Juan Islands terminals.

Travel to the San Juans

Space on the San Juan Islands ferries is apportioned to the various islands, so boats sailing to multiple destinations may depart with empty space. Peak travel times departing Anacortes are between 2-6 p.m. daily; from the San Juan Islands to Anacortes between 9 a.m.-noon, Monday through Saturday, and after 10 a.m. on Sunday. During these times, arrive at the ferry terminal with your vehicle 60 to 90 minutes before sailing time (earlier on weekends), and plan on possible overloads. WSF also recommends that walk-on travelers arrive 30 minutes in advance to ensure adequate time to park their vehicles.

Please Note: Unaccompanied vehicles (vehicles without drivers) are not permitted.

Additional Note: Our International sailing to and from Sidney, British Columbia, **will not sail** during this schedule period.


