

General Information

Welcome aboard Washington State Ferries. We hope your trip is an enjoyable one. Please take a minute to review a few simple guidelines that will help make your trip a safe one.

Understanding Our Schedule

Times in **color** are for morning (a.m.) departures and in black for afternoon/evening departures. Noon is noted as **12:00 a.m.** and one minute past noon as 12:01 p.m.; midnight is noted as 12:00 p.m. and one past midnight as **12:01 a.m.** The schedule is presented as a sailing day which begins with the first printed sailing time for that day and progresses consecutively through the last printed sailing time even though the last sailing may be past midnight and technically on the following day. Please pay special attention to annotations next to a sailing time.

Weekend or Holiday Schedules

The holiday schedule is in effect on both Independence Day, July 4, and Labor Day, September 5, for Point Defiance/Tahlequah, Fauntleroy/Vashon/Southworth and Seattle/Bainbridge Island and on Independence Day, July 4 **only**, for Edmonds/Kingston and Mukilteo/Clinton. Extra service may be provided for holiday or special event traffic on any of the routes. Please watch for notices on the vessels or at the terminals or call one of the schedule information numbers.

Security

Security regulations require that all passengers and vehicles are subject to possible security screening. Additional security measures appear in the **Safety** and **Loading** sections.

Safety

Hazardous materials are not allowed aboard a state ferry on scheduled passenger trips except those in compliance with Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to, explosive or incendiary devices, chemical, biological, radiological agents or devices, unlawful or illegally possessed firearms, and illegal fireworks.

Gasoline may be transported in limited quantities up to 12 gallons total in portable containers, not to exceed six gallons maximum per container. Containers must be UL or USCG approved, in good condition, and transported in a vehicle. All vehicles must have gas caps.

Regulations require that you shut off and tag all propane tanks prior to boarding, unless they are the primary fuel source for your vehicle. A limited number of portable propane tanks may be carried in addition to those installed in recreational

vehicles. The total amount of propane shall not exceed 100 pounds (approximately 25 gallons) whether in a single 100 pound tank or multiple smaller tanks. All propane tanks must be secured in a vehicle.

Vehicle engines must be turned off while the vessel is underway. Do not restart your car until directed by a crew member.

Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. No smoking is allowed on the car deck, in vehicles on the car deck, or on the pickleforks. All smoking materials must be extinguished during loading and unloading.

Loading

Unaccompanied vehicles (vehicles without drivers) are not permitted.

Times listed in the schedule are departure times unless otherwise noted. Vessels may cease loading three minutes in advance of sailing, except where noted.

Walk-on passengers should be on board five minutes prior to departure time.

Vehicles are loaded in order of arrival with a few exceptions. However, vehicles that are over height (7' 6") or over length (20'), including those with tall antennas, may be loaded out of sequence and must pay a

surcharge. Security requirements dictate that once loading has begun, the Captain's permission is required to disembark the vessel.

Vehicles should be in line at least 20 minutes prior to scheduled departure time. On some routes, vehicles must be moved frequently while in line. Please monitor your vehicle.

Bicyclists and persons carrying kayaks or canoes should wait near the front of the loading area, since they normally load first. Once on board, secure bikes in the place provided. **Please Note:** On the passenger-only ferry, bicycle space is limited based on vessel size. Crews will direct passengers on placement of kayaks and canoes. When leaving the vessel, please watch for and stay out of the way of vehicles. Shoes with metal sports cleats are not permitted in passenger areas.

Animals, except service animals, are not allowed in terminal buildings or above the car decks, unless they are in a pet container. Animals that are not people-friendly should be muzzled or transported in a pet carrier.

Lost and Found

Please check that you have all your personal items before departing the ferry. If you should lose something, please contact 206-515-3439 for assistance.

Fares

A receipt will be issued for all sales. If a receipt is not issued, or if there is a discrepancy, please call 206-515-3482 or send a description of the transaction to the address on the back of this schedule, Attn: Operations Revenue Control.

Cash, in-state checks, and travelers checks are accepted as payment. Major credit cards are also accepted, except at the San Juan Islands terminals.

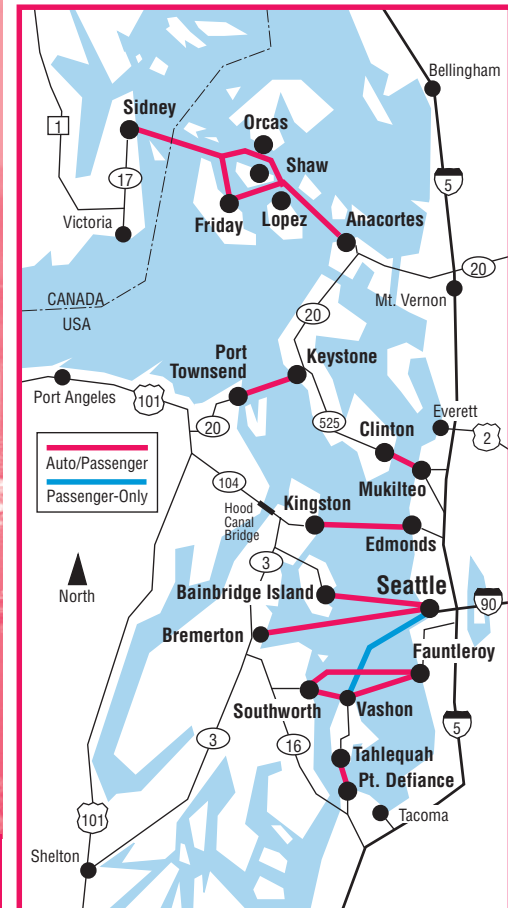

Special Travel Notes: Anacortes / Sidney, BC Route

and in line one hour and 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure. Reservations are strongly recommended.

International Reservations: Vehicle reservations are *recommended* for travel to or from Sidney, BC. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance by calling 206-464-6400 or 888-808-7977 (WA & BC).

International Travel: Visitors traveling to and from Canada are subject to inspection by U.S. Customs and Border Protection and Canadian Immigration and Canadian Customs.

The best proof of citizenship is either a valid passport or a birth certificate with photo identification. (**Note:** A driver's license, social security card, or voter registration card are *not proof of citizenship*.) If you are not a U.S. citizen, but are a permanent resident, you must have an alien resident card (green card). Children under the age of 18 not accompanied by an adult need proof of citizenship and a notarized letter from their parent or guardian giving permission to enter the U.S. or Canada.

Vehicles and baggage are subject to inspection. Articles you bring into either country are subject to being taxed.

Travel to the San Juans: Vehicle space on the ferries is apportioned to the four islands we serve so that ferries traveling to multiple destinations may depart with empty space. Peak travel times from Anacortes are Thursday and Friday afternoons and Saturday mornings. Peak travel times from the islands are Sunday all day and Monday mornings. If you plan to travel during these times, check our web site for up-to-date travel information, recommended arrival times and wait times for customers traveling with vehicles on Washington State Ferries. WSF also recommends that walk-on travelers arrive 60 minutes in advance to ensure adequate time to park their vehicles.

Note: Unaccompanied vehicles (i.e., vehicles without drivers) are not permitted.
