

General Information

Welcome aboard Washington State Ferries. To ensure your trip is a safe and enjoyable one, please take a moment to read the following guidelines.

Understanding Our Schedule

Times in **color** are for morning (a.m.) departures and in black for afternoon/evening departures. Noon is noted as **12:00 a.m.** and one minute past noon as 12:00 p.m.; midnight is noted as **12:01 a.m.** The schedule is presented as a sailing day which begins with the first printed sailing time for that day and progresses consecutively through the last printed sailing time even though the last sailing may be past midnight and technically on the following day. Please pay special attention to annotations next to a sailing time.

Weekend or Holiday Schedules

There are no holiday schedules during the winter schedule period. Extra service may be provided for special

event traffic on any of the routes. Please watch for notices on the vessels, at the terminals, or call one of the schedule information numbers.

Security

Security regulations require that all passengers and vehicles are subject to possible security screening. Additional security measures appear in the **Safety** and **Loading** sections.

Safety

Hazardous materials are not allowed aboard a state ferry on scheduled passenger trips except those in compliance with Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to explosive or incendiary devices, chemical, biological, radiological agents or devices, unlawful or illegally possessed firearms, and illegal fireworks.

Gasoline may be transported in limited quantities up to 12 gallons in portable containers, not to exceed six (6) gallons maximum per container. Containers

must be UL approved and in good condition. All vehicles must have gas caps.

Regulations require that you shut off and tag all propane tanks prior to boarding, unless they are the primary fuel source for your vehicle. A limited number of portable propane tanks may be carried in addition to those installed in recreational vehicles. The total amount of propane shall not exceed 100 pounds whether in a single 100 pound tank or multiple smaller tanks. All propane tanks must be secured.

Vehicle engines must be turned off while the vessel is underway. Do not restart your car until directed by a crew member.

Smoking is not allowed on WSF vessels. All smoking materials must be extinguished before loading the vessel.

Loading

Unaccompanied vehicles (vehicles without drivers) are not permitted.

Times listed in the schedule are departure times unless otherwise noted. Vessels may cease loading three minutes in advance of sailing, except where noted.

Walk-on passengers should be on board five minutes prior to sailing time.

Vehicles are loaded in order of arrival with a few exceptions. However, vehicles that are over height (7'6" or over length (20'), including those with tall antennas, may be loaded out of sequence and must pay a surcharge. Security requirements dictate that once loading has begun, the Captain's permission is required to disembark the vessel.

Vehicles should be in line at least 20 minutes prior to scheduled departure time. Please note that on some routes you may have to arrive up to 60 minutes or more prior to the scheduled sailing during peak travel times. At some terminals, vehicles must be moved frequently while in line

so drivers need to remain near their vehicles.

Bicyclists and persons carrying kayaks or canoes should wait near the front of the loading area, since they normally load first. Once on board, secure bikes in the place provided. **Please Note:** On the passenger-only ferry, bicycle space is limited based on vessel size. Crews will direct passengers on placement of kayaks and canoes. When leaving the vessel, please watch for and stay out of the way of vehicles. Shoes with metal sports cleats are not permitted in passenger areas.

Animals, except service animals, are not allowed in terminal buildings or above the car decks, unless they are in a pet carrier. Animals that are not people-friendly should be muzzled or transported in a pet carrier.

Lost and Found

Please check that you have all your personal items before departing the ferry. If you should lose something, please

Fares

Cash, in-state checks, and travelers checks are accepted as payment. Major credit cards are also accepted, except at the San Juan Islands terminals.


Travel to the San Juans

Vehicle space on the ferries is apportioned to each of the islands we serve, so ferries making additional island stops may depart with empty space. Peak travel times from Anacortes are Thursday and Friday afternoons and Saturday mornings. Peak travel times from the islands are Sunday all day and Monday mornings. If you plan to travel during these times, check our web site for up-to-date travel information, recommended arrival times and wait times for customers traveling with vehicles. WSF also recommends that walk-on travelers arrive 30 minutes in advance to ensure adequate time to park their vehicles.

Additional Note: Our International sailing to and from Sidney, British Columbia, **will not sail** during this schedule period.
